

Tustin Chili Cook-off and Street Fair - More Information

Check-in either Friday, June 3, 1:00pm-5:00pm or Saturday, June 4, 9:00am-12:00pm:

- Check in location is at the: **Tustin Area Senior Center, 200 "C" Street, Tustin 92780**
A check-in tent will be visible. Larry or Chuck will pick up this check-in information. We will email out the information about the location of the booth when we know it.

Vendor admission:

Vendors will be issued a "Vendor Pass" and must be worn at all times during the event. Additionally, vendors will have to wear an 'event admission bracelet' in order to participate in the event. We will also need vehicle permits for those bringing equipment in to the booth.

Vendor parking (off-site):

- Parking is available off-site at: at Columbus Tustin Recreation Center (CTRC), 17522 Beneta Way, Tustin 92780. Complimentary shuttle transportation is available from CTRC to the event and from the event to CTRC. Drivers will only transport individuals, no excess baggage.

Parking is available at several locations in the area such as the Water Facility parking lot located at Prospect Ave. and Main St., the Public Parking structure at "C" and Main Streets, and on side streets.

Layout:

- Keep in mind that the event area has been condensed from its traditional form. The event will take place at Peppertree Park and C Street (from First to Third Streets). This is the same as the event last year.
