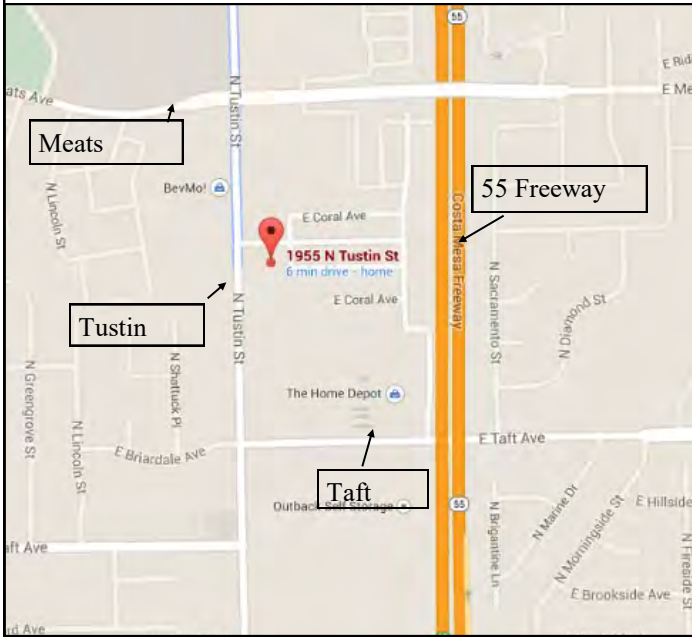
Mentor's Corner
